

2nd VP Colloquium: Guide to 2nd VP

- Criteria/Duties of 2nd VP
 - Organize spirit costumes and cheers for National Convention
 - Run 4 spirit meetings over the summer
 - Plan service projects
 - Fall Forum Can Drive
 - Help plan Fall Forum
 - Gag gifts, icebreaker, colloquia
 - Promote service throughout the state
 - Help plan State Convention
 - Determine dance and procession themes, music for dances, spirit judging
 - Cooperate with other officers and attend meetings throughout the year
- Service Ideas
 - Many volunteering opportunities around the city
 - Library, animal shelters, food banks, working a walk/run for a cause, the Zoo, tutoring a middle/elementary schooler, working a festival, church events, nursing homes
 - Scheduling and planning is important
 - Donations!!
 - Can drives, Penny Wars, toys (Toys for Tots), clothes (Coats for Kids, socks for homeless shelters), school supplies
 - Might be a better option for restricted schedules
- Planning your service
 - Scheduling is a must
 - Determine what you want to do and set a goal
 - Easier to actually get things done if you specify what/how much you want to accomplish
 - If you decided to work with an organization, reach out to receive information for how to make the donation/figure out dates and times to serve there
 - Organize all your dates
 - Helpful for communicating all your service opportunities/projects to your club and school administration in advance
 - Earlier you figure out dates=more participation
 - Organize your participation
 - Sign-up sheets
 - Ensures 20 people don't go to the library one day and 2 people go the next day
- Getting hype about service
 - Participation in service
 - Communicate and advertise
 - Announce at every meeting, start a remind, put up posters (with school's permission), post on social media
 - Be clear with all the details about the project (dates, times, deadlines, locations)

- Make it fun
 - Rewards
 - If a goal is reached, throw a pizza party or (if school has uniforms) have a free dress day (with school's permission)
 - Food is effective in everything honestly
- Spirit Tips
 - Cheers
 - Unity and participation is key
 - Some are less inclined to cheer and get hype, so reach out to EVERYBODY in the club to form relationships
 - Better relationships with club members=more inclined to participate
 - Props and costumes
 - Pipe cleaners, card board, spray paint, duct tape are my personal go-to's
